

Always On UPS Systems Canada Inc. remains open as an essential business during the covid-19 pandemic.

Always On manufactures and provides support for Uninterruptible Power Systems. These are systems that provide backup power for many critical systems including, but not limited to, emergency lighting, elevators, generators, ship systems, and many municipal infrastructure power systems.

As an essential business we will remain open with the utmost care for our employees and our customers. During this time Always On has taken the following measures to ensure the absolute safety of all involved with our business.

- Personnel entering our building must don a mask and adhere to physical distancing and Covid etiquette including: *Visitors will be reminded, upon entry, of this etiquette.*
 - o Do not visit if you feel unwell.
 - o Wash or sanitize your hands upon entry and before exiting, as well as at doorways.
 - o If someone is in a doorway or hallway first, let them pass.
 - o Follow our occupancy requirements as posted.
- We are requiring everyone returning from out of the country, having had direct contact with someone returning from out of the country, actively showing illness, or who has been instructed by a health authority, to self-isolate for 14 days post-occurrence as per BC and Federal Guidelines.
- Always On has given employees easy-to-access options for working from home.
- For those that are in the building, we have implemented a physical distancing policy and have increased sanitization and hygiene requirements as follows: work stations are to be occupied by only one worker at a time and sanitized between uses, hand sanitizers and spray sanitizers are available throughout the building as well as quality hand soap at each sink in the building, inter-office visits are discouraged unless physical distancing of 6 feet can be maintained, and our lunch room has been re-organized to accommodate a 6 foot distance and increased sanitization procedures.
- Our field services are available, however we are including additional measures upon booking a service visit from us and our technicians have been trained in hazard and risk assessment regarding covid as a part of their regular field assessments.
